In June 2003, MUTU has received recognition from the Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry and Fishery of Japan (MAFF) as a Registered Overseas Certification Body (ROCB) for product certification by issuing Japan Agricultural Standard (JAS) marking for many countries such as Indonesia, Myanmar, Cambodia, Malaysia, Vietnam, and China. National Accreditation Body (KAN) has accredited MUTU as a Quality Management System Certification Body (ISO 9001:2008) and Environmental Management System Certification Body (ISO 14001:2004). Indonesia Ecolabelling Institute (LEI) has also accredited MUTU as a Sustainable Forest Management Certification Body. Since June 2008, MUTU has been approved by RSPO Secretariat as a Certification Body for RSPO certification.
