Sime Darby Plantation Sdn. Bhd. is a member of RSPO and has been taking an active role in the RSPO certification processes and planned to achieve RSPO Sustainable Palm Oil requirement for all of its production. PT Mutuagung Lestari has arranged to conduct the assessment to the organization which operating 1 (one) palm oil mill, 1 (one) oil palm estate and 1 (one) smallholder on **05**<sup>th</sup> **to 09**<sup>th</sup> **June, 2017.**
