(RSPO Membership: 1-0008-04-000-00) – Angsana POM has applied to Mutuagung Lestari and will conduct Re-certification at Angsana Palm Oil Mill and its supply base, located in Village of Sebamban Baru, Sub district of Sei Loban, District of Tanah Bumbu, Kalimantan Selatan Province, Indonesia against the requirement of the Roundtable on Sustainable Oil Palm, Principles and Criteria of Roundtable on Sustainable Palm Oil, Generic Standard April 2013 and Supply Chain Requirement for CPO Mill, November 2014

Sime Darby Plantation Sdn. Bhd. is a member of RSPO and has been taking an active role in the RSPO certification processes and planned to achieve RSPO Sustainable Palm Oil requirement for all of its production.
