Notification on RSPO Initial Assessment of Mulia POM, PT Sepanjang Inti Surya Mulia a subsidiary of Genting Plantation Berhad (RSPO Membership 1-0086-06-000-00).

PT Sepanjang Inti Surya Mulia – Genting Plantation Berhad (RSPO Membership 1-0086-06-000-00).– Mulia POM has applied to Mutuagung Lestari and will conduct Initial Assessment at Mulia Palm Oil Mill and its supply base, located in Pangkalan Telok Village, Nanga Tayap Sub-district, Ketapang District, Kalimantan Barat Province, Indonesia against the requirement of the Indonesian National Interpretation of RSPO Principles and Criteria 2013 by INA-NITF, July 2016 (Endorsed by the RSPO Board of Governors meeting on 30th September 2016) and Supply Chain Requirement for CPO Mill, November 2014.

Genting Plantation Berhad is a member of RSPO and has been taking an active role in the RSPO certification processes and planned to achieve RSPO Sustainable Palm Oil requirement for all of its production. Mutuagung Lestari has arranged to conduct the assessment to the organization which operating 1 (one) palm oil mill and 5 (five) oil palm estate on **17th to 21th October**, **2017**.
