Notification of RSPO Re-Certification AMP Palm Oil Mill, PT AMP Plantation subsidiary of Wilmar International Ltd (RSPO Membership 2-0017-05-000-00, 16 August 2005)

Dear Stakeholders,

PT AMP Plantation has applied to Mutuagung Lestari and will conduct Re-Certification at AMP POM and its supply based, located at Tapian Kandis Village, Palembayan Sub-District, Agam District, Sumatera Barat Province, Indonesia against the requirement of Indonesia National Interpretation of the RSPO Principles and Criteria for the Production of Sustainable Palm Oil 2018 (INANI 2020).

AMP POM – PT AMP Plantation has successfully been registered in the PalmTrace IT platform with member RSPO_PO100000601. The organization is a member of RSPO and has been taking an active role in the RSPO certification processes and planned to maintain RSPO Sustainable Palm Oil requirement for all of its production. Mutuagung Lestari has arranged to conduct the assessment to the organization which operating 1 (one) palm oil mill, 5 (five) own estate and 4 (four) scheme smallholder on 21 to 26 February 2022.
